Psalm 51

1. I tried to run from God and it made me miserable!

"Be gracious to me, God" (vs. 1)

The Misery that David Endured

 Sin affected his sight—vs. 3
"For I am conscious of my rebellion, and my sin is always before me."

• Sin affected his mind--vs. 6 "Surely You desire integrity in the inner self"

Sin affected his hearing—vs. 8a
"Let me hear joy and gladness"

• Sin affected his body—vs. 8b "let the bones You have crushed rejoice."

• Sin affected his conscience—vs. 10a "God, create a clean heart for me" · Sin affected his spirit—vs. 10b "and renew a steadfast spirit within me."

• Sin affected his heart—vs. 12 "Restore the joy of your salvation to me."

 Affected his testimony—vs. 14
"Save me from the guilt of bloodshed, God, the God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing of Your righteousness."

2. I finally came clean with God and sought His forgiveness.

• He had confidence that God still loved him. (vs. 1)

"Be gracious to me, God, according to your faithful love; according to your abundant compassion, blot out my rebellion."

• He offered confession without alibis. (vss. 2-4)

"Completely wash away my guilt and cleanse me from my sin. 3 For I am conscious of my rebellion, and my sin is always before me."

3. I was willing to forgive myself. (v. 7)

"Purify me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow".

4. I am a new work of grace.

- God helped David feel clean again. (vss. 7, 10)
- God helped David go forward. (vs. 10b)
- God helped David to be useful again. (vs.13)

Psalm 51:16-17

"You do not want a sacrifice, or I would give it; you are not pleased with a burnt offering. 17 The sacrifice pleasing to God is a broken spirit. You will not despise a broken and humbled heart, God."
