

**Terms of service** - terms that set forth the nature, scope, and limits of a service that the service's users agree to.

**Luke 14:25-27** - <sup>5</sup> *Large crowds were traveling with Jesus, and turning to them he said:* <sup>26</sup> *“If anyone comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even their own life—such a person cannot be my disciple. <sup>27</sup> And whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple.*

### **Countercultural**

**Matthew 16:25-26**-<sup>25</sup> *For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it. <sup>26</sup> What good will it be for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul?*

**2 Corinthians 10:3-4** - <sup>3</sup> *For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. <sup>4</sup> The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds.*

### **Deliberate – Intentional**

**John 6:38** - *Jesus said,* <sup>38</sup> *For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me.*

**John 18:33-37** - *Pilate then went back inside the palace, summoned Jesus and asked him, “Are you the king of the Jews?” <sup>34</sup> “Is that your own idea,” Jesus asked, “or did others talk to you about me?” <sup>35</sup> “Am I a Jew?” Pilate replied. “Your own people and chief priests handed you over to me. What is it you have done?” <sup>36</sup> Jesus said, “My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place.”<sup>37</sup> “You are a king, then!” said Pilate. Jesus answered, “You say that I am a king. In fact, the reason I was born and came into the world is to testify to the truth.*

### **Willingly**

**John 10:18** – *Jesus said. <sup>18</sup> No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord.*

### **Sacrificial –**

**John 3:16** - <sup>6</sup> *For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.*

**1 John 4:9-11** - *This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. <sup>10</sup> This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. <sup>11</sup> Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.*

**Bottom Line** – *Jesus is not asking for your commitment to Him to be any different than His commitment to you.*
