We are growing.

- We are working on hosting a few more services throughout the year at the school. (tentative based on the school calendar)

We are reengaging in the conversation of the feasibility of moving sooner on building the new building sooner than originally anticipated.

We are working on getting some hard data:

- building quotes
- current property appraisals
- projected future financial data.

2021 - purchased land north of here close to the school.

September 2023 – Labor Day Weekend beginning balance.

\$158,000 remaining total loan.

As of today, the balance is at \$75,000.

Balance \$75,000 divided by 100 weekly contributions = \$750

Luke 5:8-10 - ⁸ When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!" ⁹ For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken, ¹⁰ and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners.

Luke 5:10-11 - Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people." ¹¹ So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.

Let's follow with bold faith and watch God break the nets.

Hebrews 12:1-2 - Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, ² fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith.
