2 Timothy 2:23 *Again I say, don't get involved in foolish, ignorant arguments that only start fights.*

Recognize.

- The goal is to point people to Christ. It is to understand the other person.

2 Timothy 2:24-26 - ²⁴ A servant of the Lord must not quarrel but must be kind to everyone, be able to teach, and be patient with difficult people.

²⁵ Gently instruct those who oppose the truth. Perhaps God will change those people's hearts, and they will learn the truth. ²⁶ Then they will come to their senses and escape from the devil's trap. For they have been held captive by him to do whatever he wants.

- When the conversation has turned foolish (when it has escalated, when its gossip, when it attacks the person)

Proverbs 26:20 - Without wood a fire goes out; without a gossip a quarrel dies down.

Take Control Your words, your emotions, your thought process, your motives. Turn your filter on before engaging.

PROVERBS 25:28 - A person without self-control is like a city with brokendown walls.

Psalm 141:3 - Set a guard over my mouth, LORD; keep watch over the door of my lips.

Minimize.

- The collateral damage,

Ephesians 4:29 - Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.

Be Choosey

- About what you engage, about what you post. Not everything needs your input. May you delete more than you post.

James 1:19-20 - My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, ²⁰ because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.

Kenny Rogers once said – You've got to know when to hold'em, know when to fold'em, know when to walk away, and know when to run.
