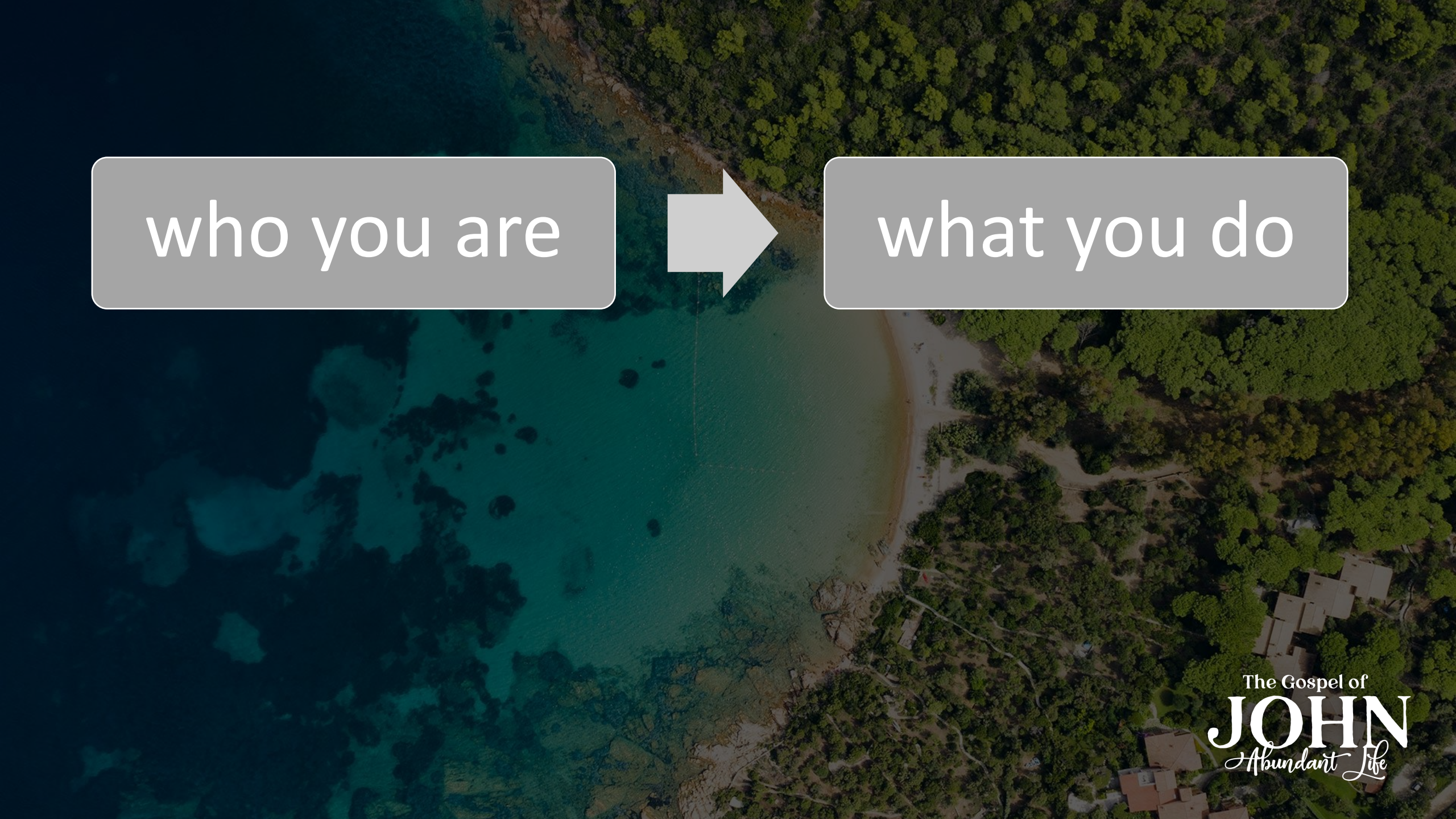


**What Jesus doesn't flow into who he
