PART 11 - FASTING AND DYSFUNCTIONAL APPETITES

Mark 2:18-22

Now John's disciples and the Pharisees were fasting. And people came and said to him, "Why do John's disciples and the disciples of the Pharisees fast, but your disciples do not fast?" And Jesus said to them, "Can the wedding guests fast while the bridegroom is with them? As long as they have the bridegroom with them, they cannot fast. The days will come when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast in that day. No one sews a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old garment. If he does, the patch tears away from it, the new from the old, and a worse tear is made. And no one puts new wine into old wineskins. If he does, the wine will burst the skins—and the wine is destroyed, and so are the skins. But new wine is for fresh wineskins."

Reasons for Fasting

- What tests the contents of the heart best? Tragedy or comfort?
- "More than any other discipline, fasting reveals the things that control us. This is a wonderful benefit to the true disciple who longs to be transformed into the image of Jesus Christ. We cover up what is inside of us with food and other things." Richard Foster
- If you can do without food you can do without other things as well

Characteristics of Christian Fasting

- Strategic weapon against sin and hunger for the world
- Go without anything to preserve the sweet longings of our homesickness for God
- Not restricted to food

Fasting Attitude

Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ ... Philippians 3:8

Thus the Lord used to speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend. Exodus 33:11
