

Sin and Suffering

Before sin entered the world, there was no suffering All suffering in a general sense is connected to sin All sin leads to some kind of direct suffering Sometimes God directly afflicts people with illness or death as judgement on their sin Not all suffering is connected to specific sin While not all physical suffering is directly connected to a specific sin, all suffering is connected to sin generally

dobbed Jesus in his suffering was directly connected to his sin


didn't know who Jesus was after he was healed









