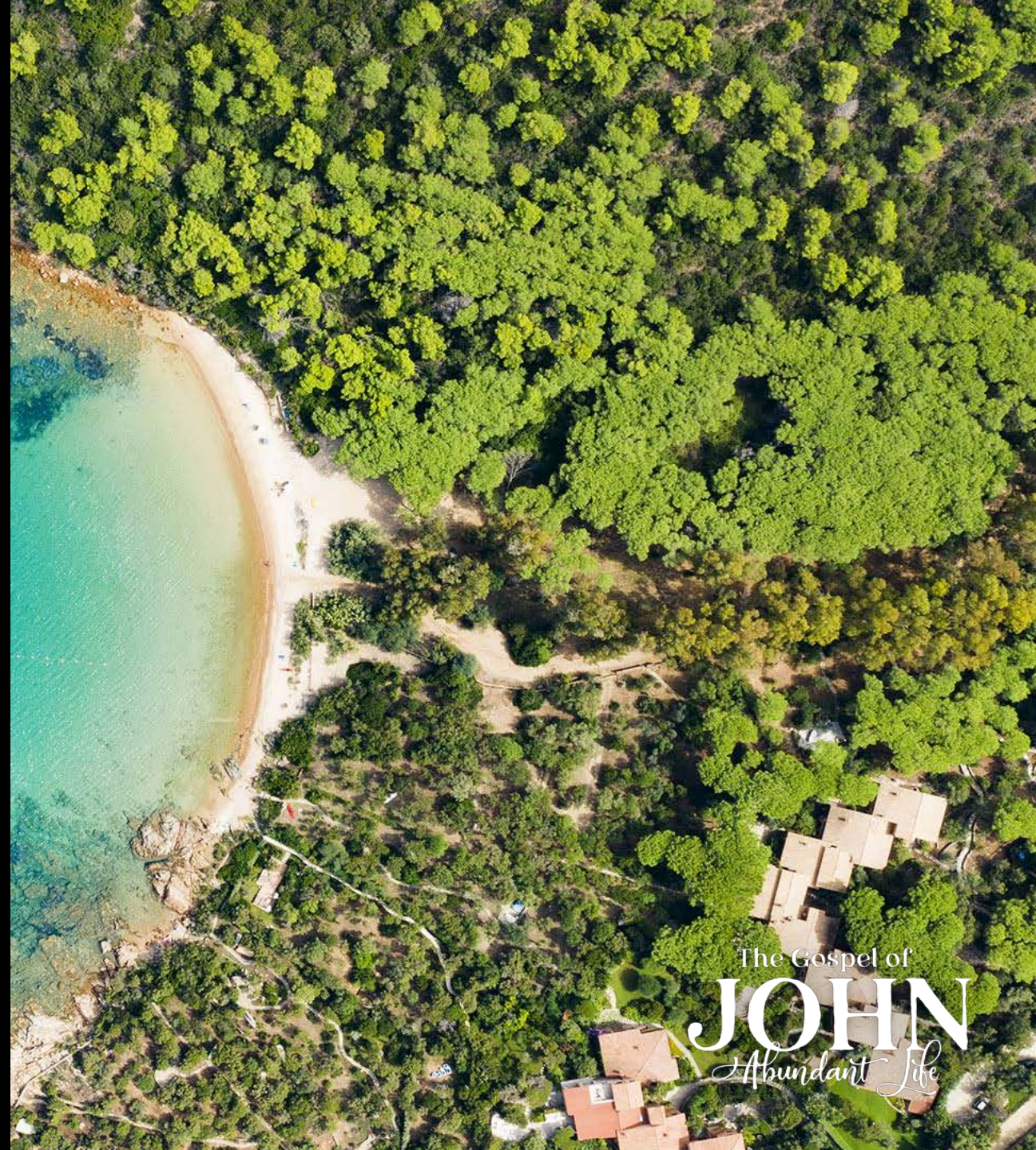

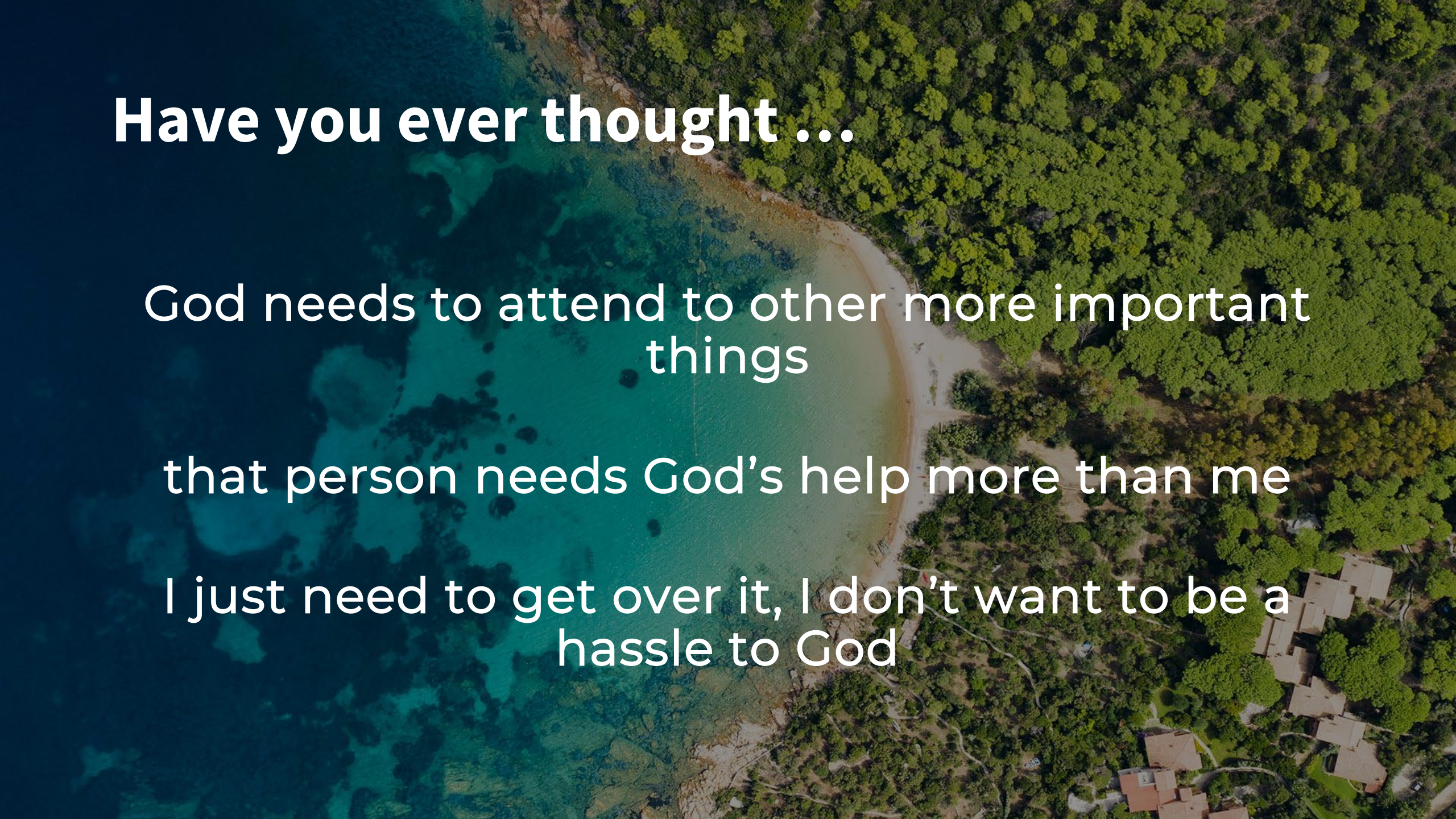

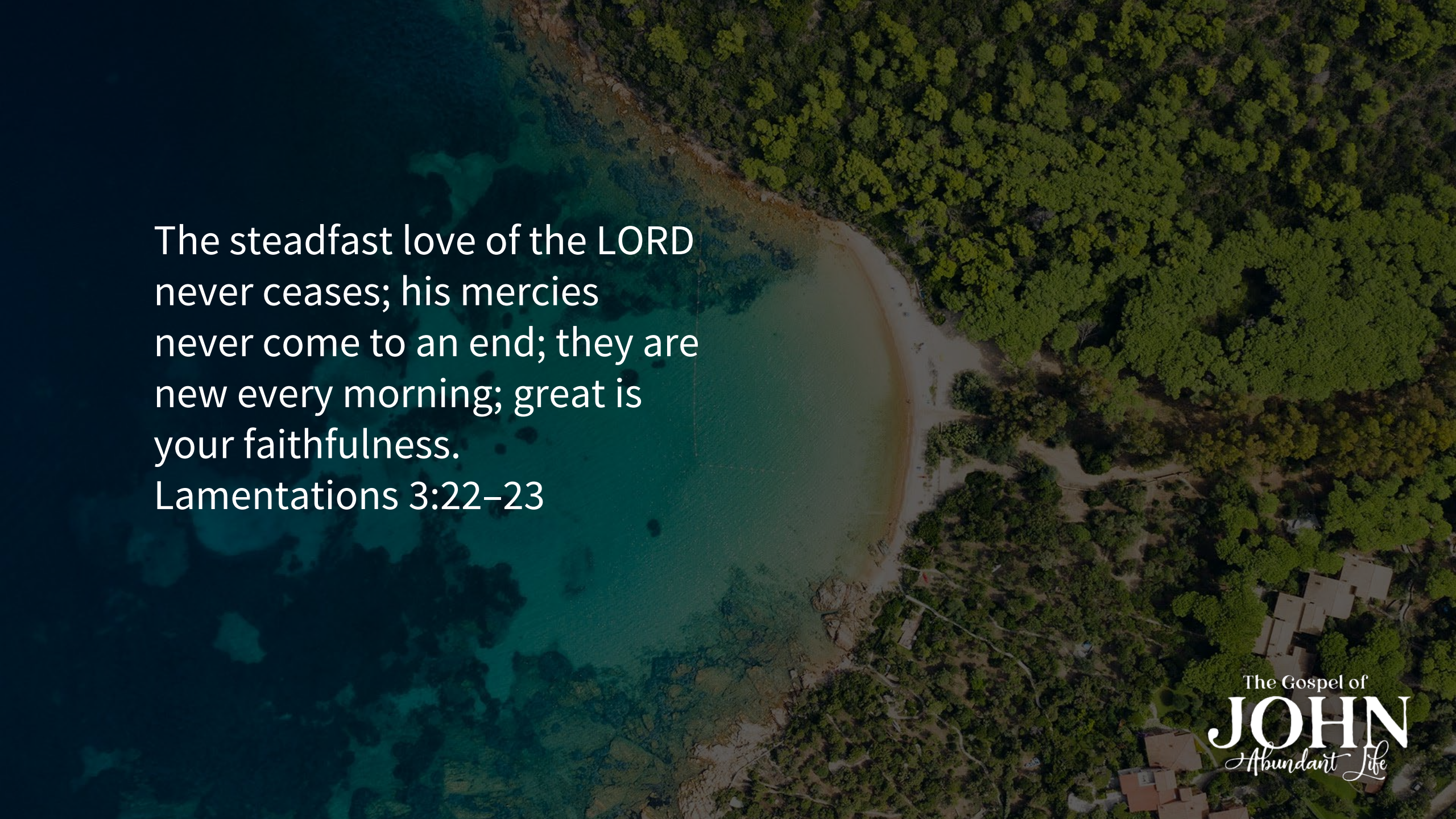


Have you ever thought ...

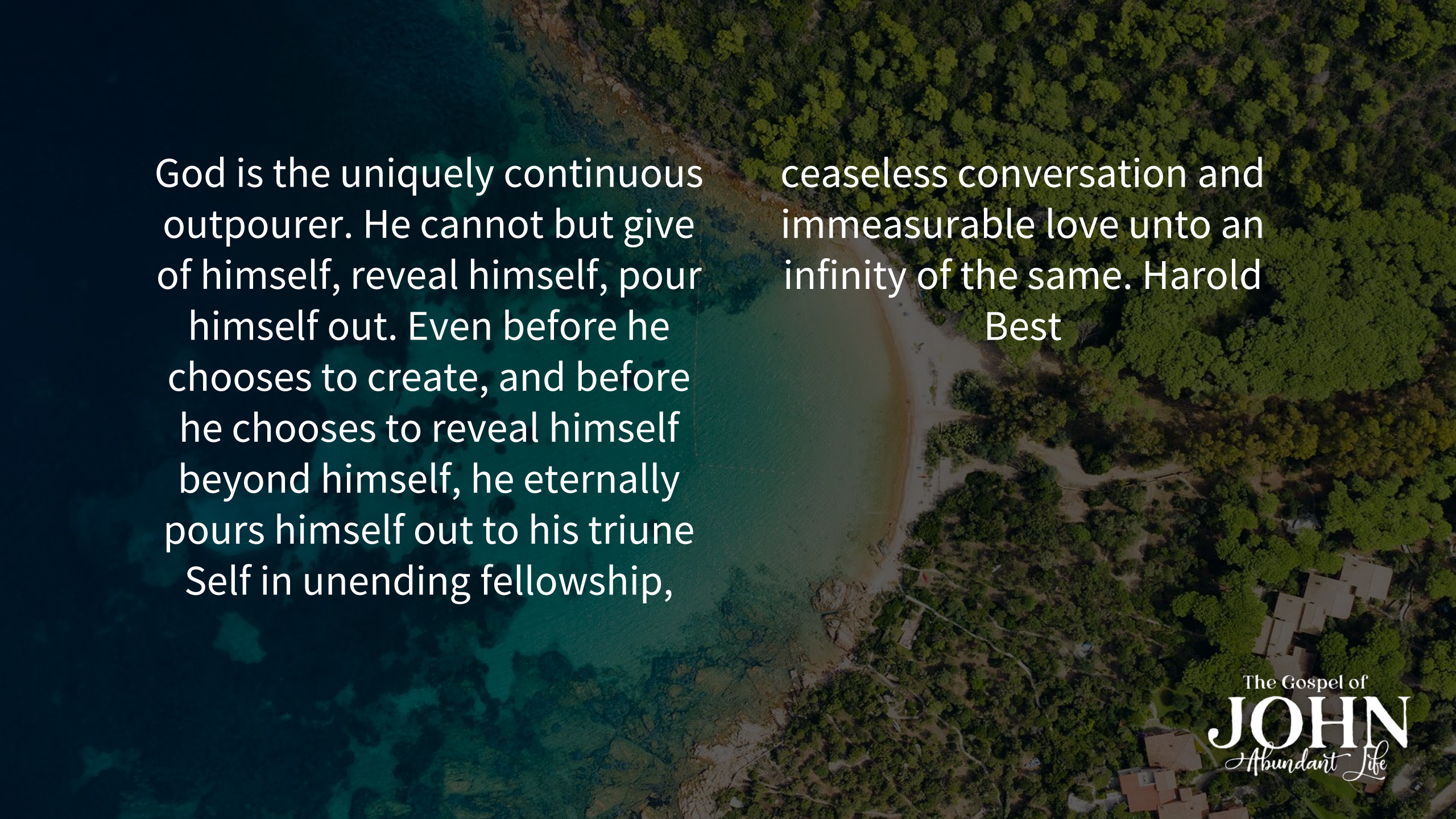
God needs to attend to other more important things

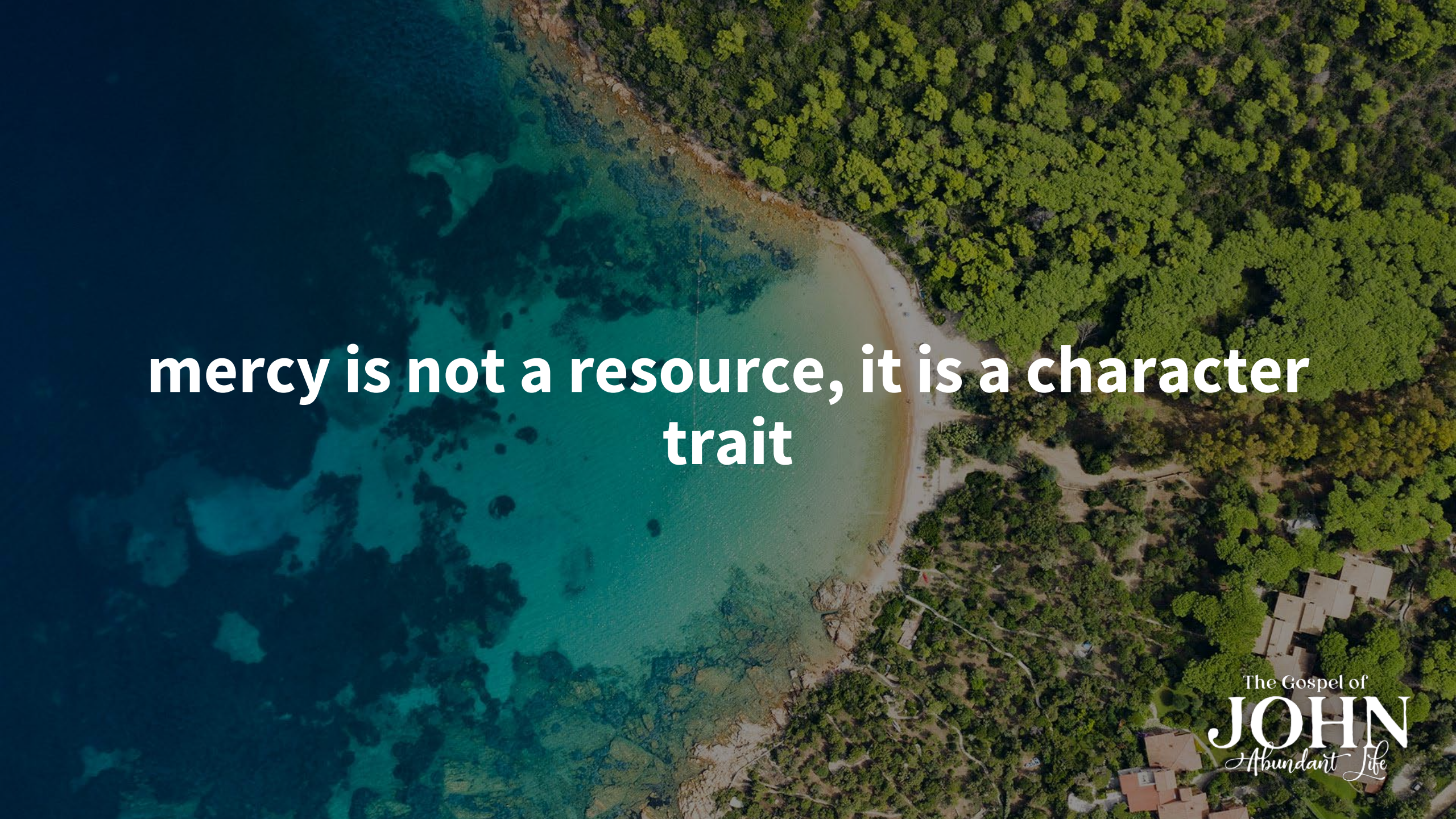
The steadfast love of the LORD

Self in unending fellowship,

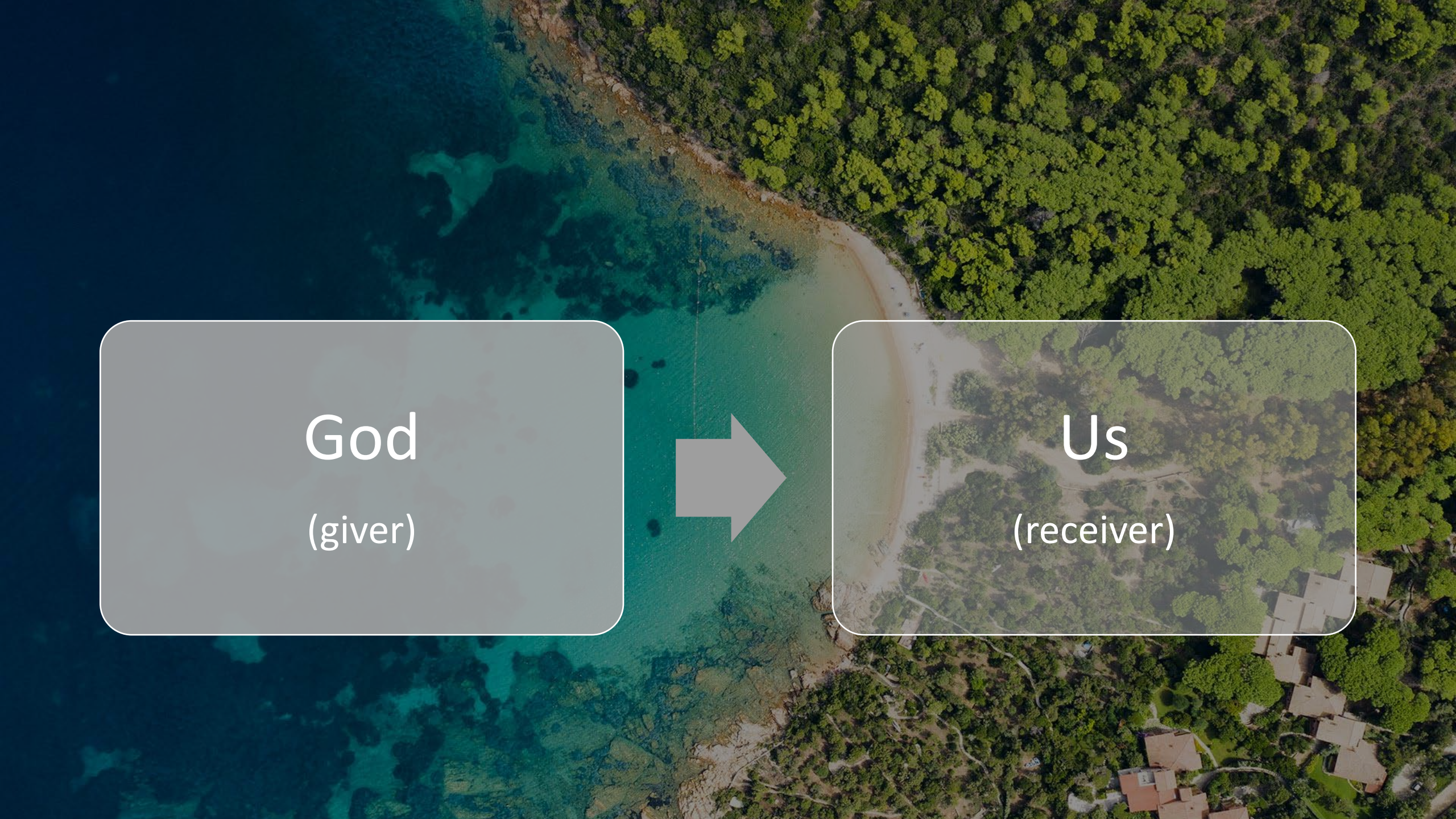
