involves risk.**

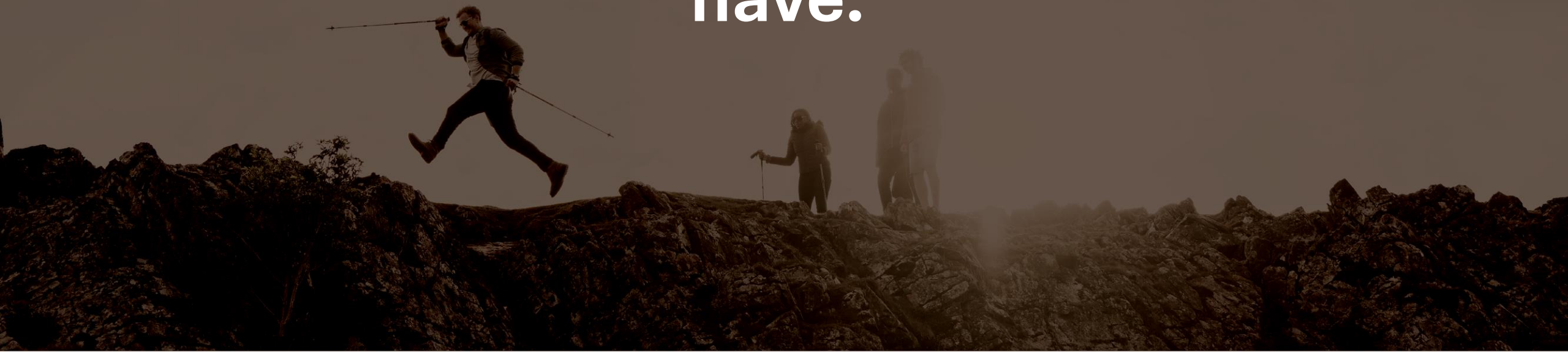


**Do you want to be frozen by fear and
