for I have sought out your precepts.”

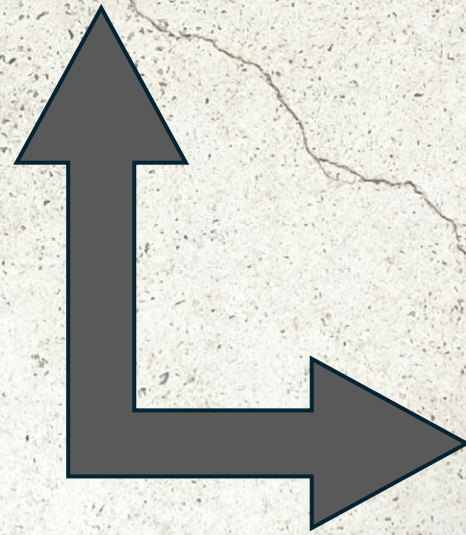
Verse 68 “You are good, and what you do is good;

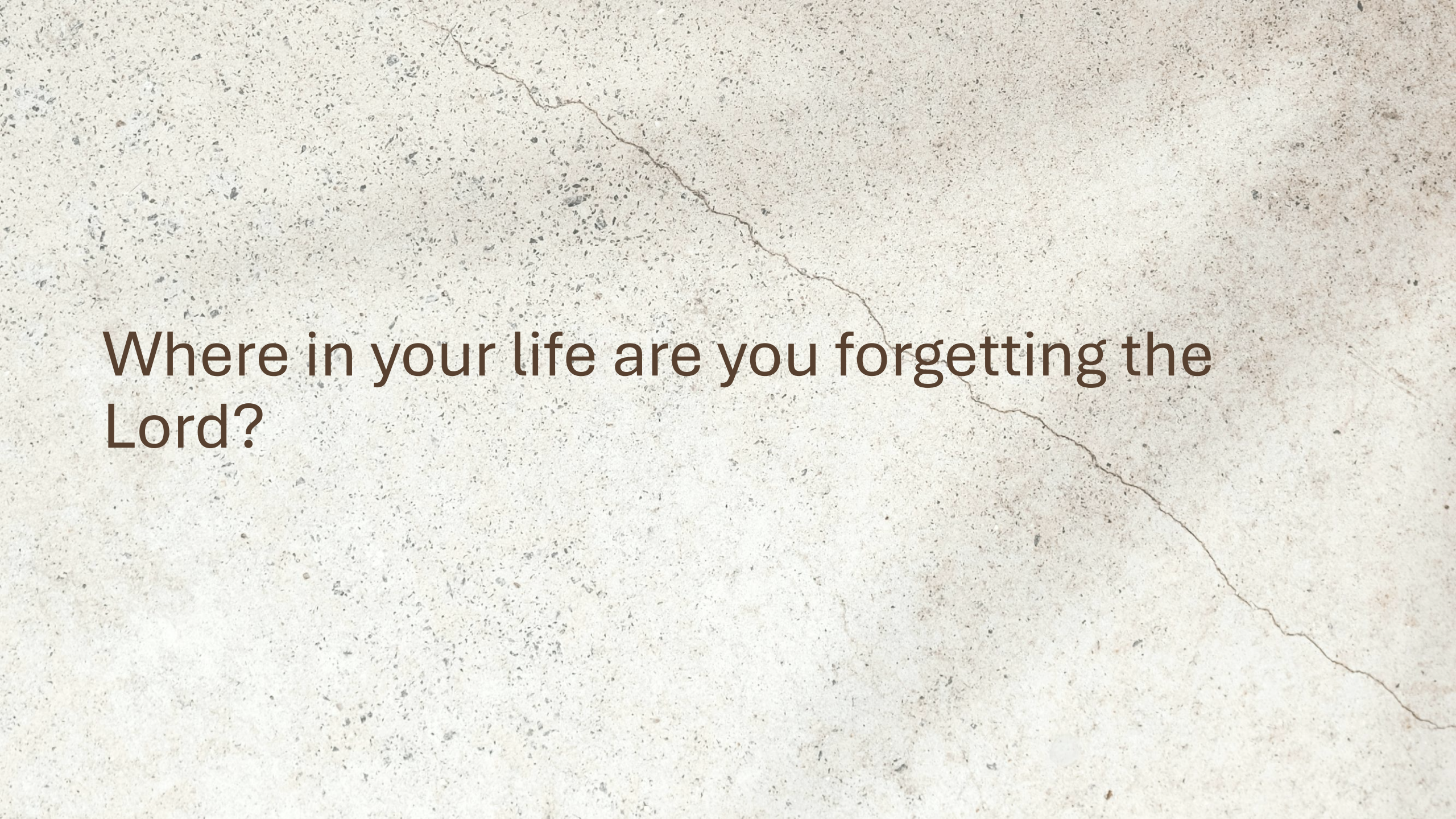
