Message: Blessed Are the Persecuted (series: # Blessed)

November 26, 2023

PRIMARY PASSAGE: Matthew 5:10-12 (ESV)

Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. "Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

MESSAGE HIGHLIGHT

We often think of the persecution of Christians as something really horrible and unfortunate, which is true. However, Jesus portrays it in a positive light as something that makes one to be blessed. This blessedness for the believer is a great reward in the future and brings great rejoicing in the present.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 2. Why should we think of persecution as a blessing rather than a misfortune?
- 3. How are Christians being persecuted here in the United States and in different parts of the world today?
- 4. What might be right and wrong responses by Christians to unjust mistreatments that they face?
- 5. In what particular ways can we support Christians who are facing persecution in different parts of the world today?
