

## **Sermon Study | 6 Words that Can Change Your Life**

### **Help | Luke 7:1-10**

### **September 29, 2019**

*Dive deeper into this week's message and passages from the Bible. Here are some questions to help you guide your group discussion..*

**It's by faith that we are saved. Faith that believes, and a humble soul that cries out for help. And Jesus has made it known exactly how he will respond. He will respond with 'yes, I will help you.' That's what makes Jesus marvel. When we believe in Him. When we place our faith in Him and we say, "Jesus, I believe because of the fact that you overcame death and sin—and I believe you can help me do the same." He is not done helping us.**

**Read Luke 7:1-10. The Roman soldier in the story places his faith in the help that only Jesus can provide. Despite not being raised in the church, he decided to place his faith in Jesus. The soldier humbled himself when he asked for help. Instead of being embarrassed, he sent to ask Jesus for help, even when he knew he might not be worthy of it.**

- Why don't you ask for help? What is something you need help with, but are afraid to ask for?
- How does pride interfere in asking for help? Does asking for help make you feel embarrassed? How do you need to humble yourself in order to ask for help?
- What kind of help do you need from Jesus? How and when will you ask for it?

**Read 2 Corinthians 3:18. God wants to help us look more like Jesus. This is called sanctification. God is so willing help us, that He sent His Spirit, the Helper, to help us look like Jesus and reflect His glory to the world.**

- What do you think it means to look more like Jesus? In what ways can God help us look more like Jesus?
- What steps do you need to take to look more like Jesus? How will you start?
