WARM-UP QUESTION

What was the best Christmas gift you received when you were a kid?

DISCUSS

Start your discussion by sharing what stood out to you from Sunday's message. Did you have any new insights or key takeaways?

Read <u>Luke 10:38-42</u> (For this section, we suggest reading the passage in the NIV translation.)

- What differences do you see between Mary and Martha's actions in this passage? What stands out to you about each of them?
- Who do you identify with more Mary or Martha? List any positives and negatives of their responses in this interaction with Jesus. How do those interactions connect to your life?
- Read verses 41-42 again. What words or phrases do you see in this text? What did Mary choose that was "better"?
- How can you be sure to choose what Jesus says is "better" more often? If you did, how would your thoughts, relationships and choices look different?

Read Isaiah 43:1-4

- What images stand out in this passage? How do they enhance your understanding of the text?
- What does this passage teach you about God's character? Name some of the characteristics of God that you see. (Not sure what God's characteristics are? Check out this list as a starting point!)
- Do you truly believe that you are fearfully and wonderfully created by God and that He knows your name? Spend a few minutes reflecting on that question before you respond.
 What keeps you from fully embracing that? How would your thought life look different if you believed and embraced those truths?
- When you believe that God knows your name, how does that help you choose what is "better" as we discussed with the first passage? How are the two ideas connected?
