## **SERMON STUDY**

Read these verses before you begin your discussion: John 13:1-20

Dive deeper into this week's message and passage from the Bible. Here are some questions to help you guide your group discussion.

Have you ever been the "most important" person in the room? How did you handle it?

As you read this passage about Jesus washing his disciples feet, what stood out to you? What did you notice?

Jesus was the most important and most influential person in every room, and yet he was also the greatest servant. True greatness is found when we recognize how much we need Jesus, and then out of his love for us, we can serve others. Who are you serving right now? How has serving them changed your perspective of God?

## **DAILY BIBLE READING**

Need a review of what we're reading in Daily Bible Reading? Here's a glance at what we're being challenged with this week.

Day one: John 13:1-5 | When you're up against hardship, what is your response?

Day two: John 13:6-11 | How do you serve people around you? Would they describe you as self-sacrificing? Day three: John 13:12-17 | Who has God called you to serve this week? How can you go out of your way to serve him or her?

Day four: John 13:18-20 | If you're serving someone who is difficult to love, keep going.

Day five: John 13:1-20 | Reflect: What do you notice that you didn't notice earlier? What is God teaching you through this passage? How will you respond?
