WARM-UP QUESTION

What is your most vivid dream? What did it feel like after you woke up from it?

DISCUSS

Start your discussion by sharing what stood out to you from Sunday's sermon. Were there any new insights or key takeaways for you?

Read Genesis 37:3-11

- What actions do you see in this text? What emotions come out as a response to the actions?
- How would you have responded if you were Joseph? If you were his brothers?
- Where do you see God in this Scripture? What does this teach us about how God interacts with His people?

Read Genesis 41:1-8 & 25-32

- How is this section of scripture the same as the first text? What is different about it?
- What themes do you see in the text? Where do you see repetition?
- What does Joseph's response to Pharaoh tell you about his character? Does anything surprise you about it?
- Has God ever spoken to you through your dreams? How do you discern when you hear His voice?

Read Genesis 45:1-8

- · What does this passage teach us about our plans versus God's plans?
- Based on what we learned in Joseph's story, how can we respond to the unforeseen circumstances that come up in our lives?
- What feelings does this text bring up in you? What do those feelings teach us about God?

RESPOND

- Based on what you just discussed, what do you think God is prompting you to do in response? When will you do it?
- Pray together as a group for the specific goals or areas of struggle that came up in your discussion. Thank God for revealing more of who He is, and ask Him to help you apply what He's prompting you to do this week.
