WARM UP QUESTION

TALK ABOUT IT

- **Read Hebrews 6:13-19 and Number 23:19-20.** What do you learn about the character of God in these verses? Talk about how your circumstances have changed over the last few weeks. What have you learned about God's unchanging nature through it?
- Have you ever tried to hold God accountable for promises He didn't make? Talk about what some of those are and how it affected your faith.
- **Read 2 Corinthians 1:8-11.** What was the result of Paul and his companions receiving more than they could handle (verses 8-9)? What has this pandemic taught you about what you rely on?
- How did the Corinthians help Paul in the midst of his trial (verse 11)? What was the result? Who, specifically, can you be praying for right now?
- How can you get to know the true promises of God better? How will knowing God's promises change your ability to trust Him?

RESPOND

What is God saying to you through His Word? How and when will you respond?
