Read these verses before you begin your discussion: Mark 10:35-45

Dive deeper into this week's message and passage from the Bible. Here are some questions to help you guide your group discussion.

As you read about James and John's interaction with Jesus, what stands out to you? What did you notice that you haven't noticed before?

James and John were looking for a way to be great—they wanted to be seated next to Jesus to be more important. What area of your life do you seek to be great? Wealth? Success? Beauty? Achievements?

Petie challenged us to ponder two key questions this weekend: How was Jesus able to live such a selfless, servant-filled life? What makes you valuable?
