

## Seeing the Lord in Resurrection

### I. Seeing the fact – Jesus Christ has resurrected

#### A. Overcame death

John 20:6-9     6 Then Simon Peter also came, following him, and entered into the tomb; and he beheld the linen cloths lying *there*. 7 And the handkerchief which had been over His head, not lying with the linen cloths, but folded up in one place apart. 8 At that time therefore the other disciple also, who came first to the tomb, entered, and he saw and believed; 9 For as yet they did not understand the Scripture, that He had to rise from the dead.

Acts 2:24        Whom God has raised up, having loosed the pangs of death, since it was not possible for Him to be held by it.

John 11:25a     Jesus said to her, I am the resurrection and the life...

#### B. Breathed the Holy Spirit into the disciples

John 20:22      And when He had said this, He breathed into *them* and said to them, Receive the Holy Spirit.

### II. Experiencing the reality – Jesus Christ is the Spirit in you

#### A. The two *becomings*

John 1:14        And the Word became flesh and tabernacled among us (and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only Begotten from the Father), full of grace and reality.

1 Cor. 15:45     ...the last Adam became a life-giving Spirit.

#### B. Living by breathing Christ as the Spirit

1 Thes. 5:17     Unceasingly pray,

2 Cor. 3:6        ...for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life

2 Cor.3:17      Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom
