

Seeking the Person

- John 20:1 Now on the first day of the week, Mary the Magdalene came early to the tomb while it was yet dark and saw the stone taken away from the tomb.
- John 20:10-11 The disciples therefore went away again to their own home. But Mary stood outside at the tomb weeping. Then as she wept, she stooped to look into the tomb.
- John 20:15 Jesus said to her, Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?
- Mark 1:36 And Simon and those with him hunted for Him.
- Psa. 63:1 O God, You are my God; I seek You diligently. My soul thirsts for You.
- Psa. 81:10 Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it.
- Psa. 42:1 As the hart pants after the waterbrooks, so my soul pants after Thee, O God.
- Psa. 119:147 I anticipated the dawn and cried out; I hoped in Your words.
- Luke 11:9 And I say to you, Ask and it shall be given to you; seek and you shall find; knock and it shall be opened to you.
- Luke 1:53 The hungry He has filled with good things, and the rich He has sent away empty.

The following points are taken observing certain principles found in John 20:1-18:

1. The discovery of His resurrection was made by the loving seekers of the Lord Jesus.
2. As Christians, we must seek the Lord even more before we can experience His resurrection.
3. Peter and John had the revelation but not the experience.
4. Mary's experience of seeing and contacting the Lord is a wonderful pattern of having a time with the Lord, practicing the morning watch.
