Sermon: Share It

Bottom line: We share our life with others because Jesus shares his life with us.

Often times when we think about sharing the good news we think about people standing on street corners, door knocking, and handing out pamphlets. Paul offers a different way of sharing the good news. He shares his life with people. People need relationships and community and that is one of the things the church has traditionally been great at accomplishing. Let's explore how you might be able to share this good news in your life.

Discussion: Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-8; 1 Thessalonians 2:8

- 1. What part of 1 Corinthians 15:1-8 stood out to you? Share with each other.
- 2. In 1 Thessalonians 2:8, Paul shares not just the gospel but his life with the church in Thessalonica. Do you think Paul shared both the good and the bad things going on in his life?
- 3. Why can it be difficult to share with your small group the challenges you are facing in your life? How can a small group be a safe place for people to share?
- 4. Paul uses his life as a means for sharing the good news of Jesus. How and with whom could you share your life with as a means of showing the good news of Jesus?

Application

- 5. Do you know of anyone who is lonely? How can you invite that person into a Christian community?
- 6. What does a small group look like to you? How can your small group be good news to each other and the community as you share your lives together?
