### Overview

Sermon: *A Lifelong Search*

*Simeon took him in his arms and praised God, saying:*

*“Sovereign Lord, as you have promised, you may now dismiss your servant in peace.*

*For my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all nations:  
a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel.” - Luke 2: 28-32 (NIV)*

1. Reflect on a time when you were waiting for something from God. What were you praying for and how long did it take for God to answer? What does waiting on God do for our faith?
2. Read aloud Luke 2:22-40. With a partner each of you summarize the chapter in your own words. Help each other fill in the gaps. Re-read aloud the parts that were most intriguing to you.
3. What is your understanding of the passage?
4. What do you learn about God from this passage?
5. What do you learn about people from this passage?

6. How will you put into practice what you learned from Luke 2:22-40?
7. Who are you going to share what you experienced from God from John 2? What can you pray about from this passage?
