Overview

Sermon: Freely Give

Freely you have received; freely give. – Jesus Matthew 10: 8b (NIV)

In this chapter Jesus sends out the 12 disciples in what can be described as the limited commission. One of the themes that stands out within Jesus' instructions is the reliance on God's grace and provision. What they have to offer has been given to them by God. The good news of the kingdom starts and ends with God's grace.

- 5. What do you learn about people from this passage?
