"When you come looking for me, you'll find me." Jeremiah 29:13 (MSG)

Discussion

- 1. What is something that you've been searching for but have been unable to find. What is something today that most people possess that was once difficult to own? What changed?
- 2. Read aloud Luke 2:1-21. With a partner each of you summarize the chapter in your own words. Help each other fill in the gaps. Re-read aloud the parts that were most intriguing to you.
- 3. Why did the angels appear to the shepherds? How did Mary and Joseph experience the joy of the good news through the shepherd's testimony?
- 4. God wants to be found. Why is God self-revealing? How have you experienced the self-revealing God? How do you experience the hiddenness of God? Why do we have both?
- 5. How do you experience the joy of the good news through someone else's testimony? How have you shared the good news to bring joy to someone else? Why are both important?
- 6. What does the passage tell us about what Mary did when she heard the shepherd's testimony? Why is it important to revisit the good news of Jesus often?

- 7. How will you put into practice what you learned from Luke 2:1-21?
- 8. Who are you going to share what you experienced from God from Daniel 6? What can you pray about from this passage?
