The Book of Galatians / Galatians 5:16-26

Galatians 5:16-26 NASB95

But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh. For the flesh sets its desire against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the Law. Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit. Let us not become boastful, challenging one another, envying one another.

LN 8.4 physical body (1Ti 3:16); 3. LN 9.11 people, a physical human being (Jn 1:14; 1Pe 1:24); 4. LN 9.12 human, physical nature (Heb 12:9); 5. LN 10.1 nation, ethnic group (Ro 11:14); 6. Desire - ἐπιθυμέω (epithymeō): vb.; \equiv Str 1937; TDNT 3.168—1. LN 25.12 desire greatly, long for, desire (Mt 13:17; Lk 15:16; 16:21; 17:22; 22:15; 1Ti 3:1; Heb 6:11; 1Pe 1:12; Rev 9:6+); 2. LN 25.20 lust, covet, an evil desire (Mt 5:28; Ac 20:33; Ro 7:7; 13:9; 1Co 10:6; Gal 5:17; Jas 4:2+)

Opposition - ἀντίκειμαι (antikeimai): vb.; ≡ Str 480; TDNT 3.655—LN 39.1 be hostile toward, be an opponent, be an adversary (<u>Lk 13:17</u>; <u>21:15</u>; <u>1Co 16:9</u>; <u>Gal 5:17</u>; <u>Php 1:28</u>; <u>2Th 2:4</u>; <u>1Ti 1:10</u>; <u>5:14</u>+)

Romans 8:5 NASB95

For those who are according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who are according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit.

Matthew 26:41 NASB95

"Keep watching and praying that you may not enter into temptation; the spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak."

James 1:14 NASB95

But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust.

Romans 12:2 NASB95

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your

mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and

perfect.

Romans 8:3-4 NASB95

For what the Law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh, God did: sending His

own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and as an offering for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh,

so that the requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us, who do not walk according to the

flesh but according to the Spirit.

Galatians 2:20 NASB95

"I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me;

and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and

gave Himself up for me.

Romans 8:38–39 NASB95

For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things

present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will

be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 1:32 NASB95

and although they know the ordinance of God, that those who practice such things are worthy of death, they not only do the same, but also give hearty approval to those who practice them.
