Restoration in Gentleness

The Book of Galatians / Galatians 6:1-5

Galatians 6:1-5 NASB95

Brethren, even if anyone is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; *each one* looking to yourself, so that you too will not be tempted. Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ. For if anyone thinks he is something when he is nothing, he deceives himself. But each one must examine his own work, and then he will have *reason for* boasting in regard to himself alone, and not in regard to another. For each one will bear his own load.

Restore - καταρτίζω (katartizō): vb.; ≡ Str 2675; TDNT 1.475—1. LN 75.5 make adequate, furnish completely, make sufficient, hence, in some contexts, mend, restore (Mt 4:21; Mk 1:19; Lk 6:40; Ro 9:22; 1Co 1:10; 2Co 13:11; Gal 6:1; Heb 10:5; 13:21; 1Pe 5:10+)

Gentleness - πραΰτης (prautēs), ητος (ētos), ἡ (hē): n.fem.; \equiv Str 4240; TDNT 6.645—LN 88.59 gentleness, meekness, humility (1Co 4:21; 2Co 10:1; Gal 5:23; 6:1; Eph 4:2; Col 3:12; 2Ti 2:25; Tit 3:2; Jas 1:21; 3:13; 1Pe 3:16+)

Burdens - βάρος (baros), ους (ous), τό (to): n.neu.; \equiv Str 922; TDNT 1.553—1. LN 22.4 hardship, burden (Mt 20:12; Ac 15:28; Gal 6:2; Rev 2:24+); 2. LN 78.23 tremendous, weight, a high point on a scale of extent (2Co 4:17+)

Galatians 5:19–21 NASB95

Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.
