The Book of 1 Corinthians / 1 Corinthians 11:1–16

Head Coverings

1 Corinthians 11:7–16 NASB95

For a man ought not to have his head covered, since he is the image and glory of God; but the woman is the glory of man. For man does not originate from woman, but woman from man; for indeed man was not created for the woman's sake, but woman for the man's sake. Therefore the woman ought to have a *symbol of* authority on her head, because of the angels. However, in the Lord, neither is woman independent of man, nor is man independent of woman. For as the woman originates from the man, so also the man *has his birth* through the woman; and all things originate from God. Judge for yourselves: is it proper for a woman to pray to God *with her head* uncovered? Does not even nature itself teach you that if a man has long hair, it is a dishonor to him, but if a woman has long hair, it is a glory to her? For her hair is given to her for a covering. But if one is inclined to be contentious, we have no other practice, nor have the churches of God.

Genesis 1:26–27 NASB95

Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

Genesis 2:7 NASB95

Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.

Genesis 2:22–23 NASB95

The LORD God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man. The man said, "This is now bone of my bones, And

flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man.”

Then the LORD God said, “It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him.”

Man - אָדָם (‘ā·dām): n.masc.; ≡ Str 120; TWOT 25a—1. LN 9.1–9.23 person, human, i.e., a single human being of either sex (Ps 49:21[EB 20]), see also 134; 2. LN 9.1–9.23 humankind, mankind, a class of being created by God without regard to sex, with a focus as a class of creature, distinct from animals, plants, or even spiritual beings (Ge 1:26);

Helper - עֲזָרָה (‘ē·zēr): n.masc.; ≡ Str 5828; TWOT 1598a—1. LN 35.1–35.18 helper, assistant, i.e., one who assists and serves another with what is needed ([Ge 2:18](#), [20](#); [Ex 18:4](#); [Dt 33:29](#); [Eze 12:14](#); [Hos 13:9](#)); 2. LN 35.1–35.18 help, assistance, i.e., acts of supplying what is needed to another ([Dt 33:7](#), [26](#); [Ps 20:3](#)[EB 2]; [33:20](#); [70:6](#)[EB 5]; [115:9](#), [10](#), [11](#); [121:1](#), [2](#); [124:8](#); [146:5](#); [Isa 30:5](#); [Da 11:34](#)+)
