Hebrews 2:13-15

Acts 17:11

Now these were more noble-minded than those in Thessalonica, for they received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see whether these things were so.

Read: Psalm 22:1-22

Public praise prefigures Christ praising God to his people for the salvation that God has accomplished in him (Heb. 2:12).

Psalm 22:8

“Commit yourself to Yahweh; let Him rescue him;
Let Him deliver him, because He delights in him.”

Psalm 22:9 - 22:10

Yet You are He who brought me out of the womb; **You made me trust** when upon my mother's breasts. Upon You I was cast from birth; You have been my God from my mother's womb.

“Jesus Shows His great Faith/Trust in God by submitting to him and living a life in total dependence on Him”

John 6:38 (submission)

For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

John 5:30 (submission)

“I can do nothing from Myself. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

Philippians 2:6 - 2:8 (dependence)

who, although existing in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, by taking the form of a slave, by being made in the likeness of men. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Matthew 26:39 (dependence)

And He went a little beyond them, and fell on His face and prayed, saying, “**My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will.**”

Luke 23:46 (dependence)

And Jesus, crying out with a loud voice, said, “**Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit.**” Having said this, He breathed His last.

Read: Psalm 31:1-5

“Behold, I and the children whom God has given Me.”

Why The Father ?

Colossians 1:12 - 1:14

giving thanks to **the Father**, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in light. Who rescued us from the authority of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

1 John 3:1

See how great a love **the Father has given to us, that we would be called children of God; and we are.** For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.

John 3:16

“For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Why The Father

1 Peter 1:3 - 1:9

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to obtain an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and unfading, having been kept in heaven for you, who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, so that the proof of your faith, being more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ. And though you have not seen Him, you love Him, and though you do not see Him now, but believe in Him, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, receiving as the outcome of your faith the salvation of your souls.

Hebrews 11:33 - 11:40
