Elizabeth

Luke 1:5 - 1:7

In the days of Herod, king of Judea, there was a priest named Zechariah, of the division of Abijah, and he had a wife from the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elizabeth. And they were both **righteous** in the sight of God, **walking blamelessly in all the commandments and righteous requirements of the Lord**. But they had no child, because Elizabeth was barren, and they were both advanced in years.

2. Lives Holy Unto God

1 Peter 1:14 - 1:16

As obedient children, not being conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance, but like the Holy One who called you, **be holy yourselves also in all your conduct**; because it is written, “**You shall be holy, for I am holy.**”

John 14:21; 23-24 (Obedience = Love for God)

21 He who has My commandments and keeps them is the one who **loves** Me; and he who **loves** Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and will disclose Myself to him.” 23 Jesus answered and said to him, “If anyone **loves** Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will **love** him, and We will come to him and make Our dwelling with him. 24 He who does **not love** Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine, but the Father’s who sent Me.

2. Lives Holy Unto God

1 John 2:3 - 2:6 (Obedience = Love for God)

And by this we know that we have come to know Him, if we keep His commandments. The one who says, “I have come to know Him,” and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him; but whoever keeps His word, truly in him the love of God has been perfected. By this we know that we are in Him: the one who says he abides in Him ought himself to walk in the same manner as He walked.
