For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things like we are, yet without sin. The Role of The High Priest high priest in things pertaining to God

"Partly Jesus role has High Priest was to minister the things of God to His people."

The Duties of The High Priest

The Meaning: It means one who mediates in religious services and one who is holy or set apart to preform those services.

- Overseeing the responsibilities of all the subordinate priest
- Tell the people the Will of God
- Offer sin offering for Him and His people
- Interceding to God for the people

Day of Atonement (10 day of the 7 month). The High Priest would carry the sacrificial blood behind the veil in the Holy of holies and sprinkle it on the mercy seat, God's throne. He did this to make atonement for himself and the people for all their sins they committed during the year. The Sacrifices (daily and yearly) temporarily covered until the Messiah came to take way their sins.

Penal substitutionary atonement To Appease/Satisfy the wrath of God.
