- Jesus is resurrected by the power of God.
- The resurrection is affirmation of God's approval of the sin sacrifice of Jesus on the cross.
- The church, just as Jesus promised his disciples in Caesarea Philippi, becomes the "keeper of the key" to the Kingdom of God. (cf. Matthew 16:13-20)
- The followers of Jesus become living testimonies of transformation.
- What's the value of knowing this stuff?

Easter, it begins with Easter.
