

Elijah Must Come  
Matthew #113  
Matthew 17:9-13

Matthew 11:14-15 and Luke 1:13-17

When John was asked if he was Elijah he said “no.” John 1:19-23

Since Israel rejected Jesus and John’s message, John did not fulfill Elijah’s function. So we are back to the idea that the prophet Elijah himself must come and do it.

Malachi 4:5-6 and Malachi 3:1

Once again Jesus continues to tell His disciples that He is going to suffer.

The principle here echoes the principle we find in Romans 1: if someone does not respond to a little bit of light/truth they will not respond to more light/truth, if one does respond to a little bit of light/truth, they will respond to more light/truth.
