Laws of intention

Biblical defilement encompasses both ritualistic and moral/spiritual concepts, representing a state of impurity or contamination that separates an individual or community from God.

Human depravity, a theological concept asserting that sin has affected every aspect of human nature, making individuals inherently inclined towards evil and unable to choose good or saving faith on their own. This does not mean humans are as bad as they could be, but rather that sin has impacted the totality of their being, leaving them unable to please God or save themselves.
