Three Gross Errors Matthew #104 Matthew 16:1-4

Leaven = that which morally corrupts

Jesus is warning His men not to allow themselves to be permeated by this leaven or to believe any of the lies/false teaching they were hearing.

What lies?

It's a matter of faith, if you believe I can and will provide for you, you are free to be concerned about what's most important.

"Little faith" has been variously defined contextually as worry, fear, and doubt or wavering (it does not mean or imply faithlessness).

What is the leaven, the false teaching, of the Pharisees and Sadducees that we are able to apply to our lives today?

Three gross errors.

- 1. People to think that their good behavior and their religious rituals and ceremonies made them acceptable to God.
- 2. It leads to a religion of social respectability.
- 3. It leads to an attitude and an air of self-righteousness.
