E-Give

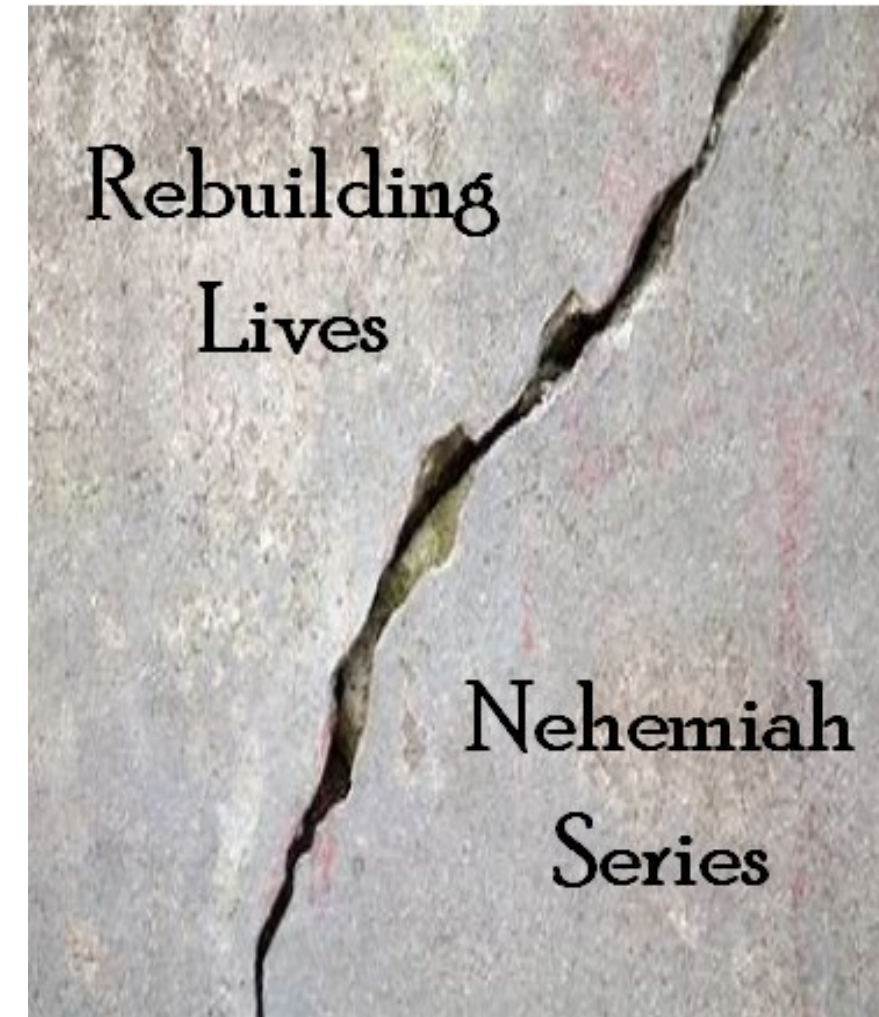
