



# HOPE When the Roof Could Blow - Abigail 1 Samuel 25

*“Yes, my soul, find rest in God; my hope comes from him. Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will not be shaken...Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge.” Ps 62:5-8*

**HOPE** = anchored expectation that God is our Rock & solution!
