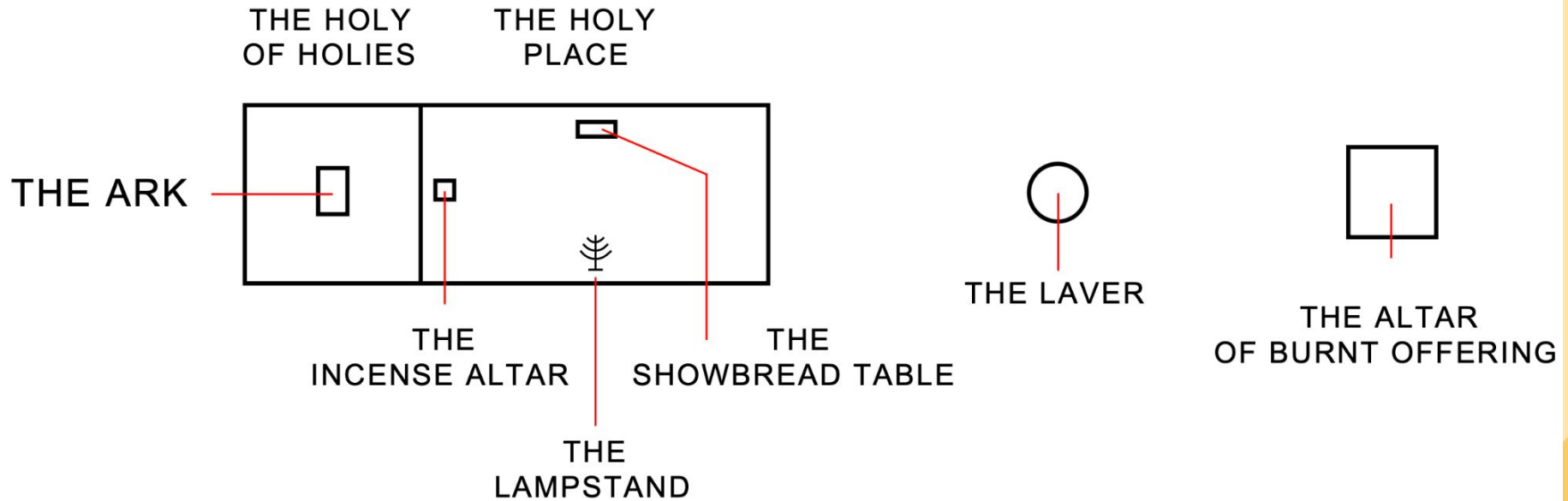

The Arrangement of Furniture Inside the Tabernacle and Its Significance



THE OUTER COURT



Hebrews 9:2-5

2 For a tabernacle was prepared, the first, in which were the lampstand and the table and the loaves that were set forth, which is called the Holy Place;

3 And after the second veil, a tabernacle, which is called the Holy of Holies,

4 Having a golden altar and the Ark of the Covenant covered about everywhere with gold, in which were the golden pot that had the manna and Aaron's rod that budded and the tablets of the covenant,

5 And above it cherubim of glory overshadowing the expiation cover, concerning which it is not now the time to speak in detail.

Exodus 30:7

And you shall put it before the veil that is over the Ark of the Testimony, before the expiation cover that is over the Testimony, where I will meet with you.

Table of the Bread of the Presence

John 6:33 For the bread of God is He who comes down out of heaven and gives life to the world.

Lampstand

John 1:4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

John 8:12 Again therefore Jesus spoke to them, saying, I am the light of the world; he who follows Me shall by no means walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.



The Holy Place (cont.)

Incense Altar

Hebrews 7:25

Hence also He is able to save to the uttermost those who come forward to God through Him, since He lives always to intercede for them.

Revelation 8:3

And another Angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer, and much incense was given to Him to offer with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne.

Ephesians 6:18

By means of all prayer and petition, praying at every time in spirit and watching unto this in all perseverance and petition concerning all the saints,

Outside:

The Expiation Cover

Rom. 3:25 Whom God set forth as a propitiation place through faith in His blood, for the demonstrating of His righteousness, in that in His forbearance God passed over the sins that had previously occurred,
Heb. 4:16 Let us therefore come forward with boldness to the throne of grace that we may receive mercy and find grace for timely help. •

The Holy of Holies - The Ark of the Testimony (cont.)

Inside:

The Hidden Manna

John 4:32 But He said to them, I have food to eat that you do not know about.

John 6:57 As the living Father has sent Me and I live because of the Father, so he who eats Me, he also shall live because of Me.

Rev. 2:17 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, to him I will give of the hidden manna, and to him I will give a white stone, and upon the stone a new name written, which no one knows except him who receives it.

The Holy of Holies - The Ark of the Testimony (cont.)

Inside:

Aaron's Budding Rod

Rom. 14:9 For Christ died and lived again for this, that He might be Lord both of the dead and of the living.

Tablets of the Testimony

Rom. 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life has freed me in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and of death.

Heb. 8:10 For this is the covenant which I will covenant with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will impart My laws into their mind, and on their hearts I will inscribe them; and I will be God to them, and they will be a people to Me.
