Living In Fellowship With God (2) and Enjoying God as our Inherited Grace as Seen in the Example of Isaac

Isaac Enjoying Grace by Receiving All From Abraham and Calling Audibly on the Name

Genesis 25:5 And Abraham gave all that he had to Isaac.

Genesis 26:25 And he built an altar there and <u>called upon the name of</u> Jehovah and pitched his tent there. And there Isaac's servants dug a well.

A Practice Beginning From the 3rd Generation of Mankind With Enosh Which Means Frail, Mortal Man:

Genesis 4:26 And to Seth also a son was born, and he called his name Enosh. At that time men began to call upon the name of Jehovah.

Abraham

Genesis 12:8 And he proceeded from there to the mountain on the east of Bethel and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east; and there he built an altar to Jehovah and <u>called upon the name of Jehovah.</u>

Moses and the Children of Israel

Deuteronomy 4:7 For what great nation is there that has a god so near to it as Jehovah our God is whenever we call upon Him?

Psalm 99:6 Moses and Aaron among His priests, / And Samuel among those who <u>called on His name</u> — / They called out to Jehovah, / And He answered them.

Psalm 50:15 And <u>call upon Me in the day of trouble</u>: / I will deliver you, and you will glorify Me.

This is the Joyful Way to Drink from the Fountain of God's Salvation:

Isaiah 12:3-4 Therefore you will draw water with rejoicing / From the springs of salvation, And you will say in that day, / Give thanks to Jehovah;

<u>call upon His name!</u> / Make His deeds known among the peoples; / Remind them that His name is exalted.

The Early Believers Practiced This Everywhere:

1 Corinthians 1:2 To the church of God which is in Corinth, to those who have been sanctified in Christ Jesus, the called saints, with <u>all those who call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ in every place</u>, who is theirs and ours:

Enabling Us to Enjoy the Fullness of His Riches:

Romans 10:12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord is Lord of all and <u>rich to all who call upon Him</u>;

Even to the Persecutors It Became a Popular Sign of Christ's Believers:

Acts:9:14 And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind <u>all who call upon Your name.</u>

v.21 And all who heard him were amazed and said, Is this not the one who ravaged those who call upon this name in Jerusalem and came here for this, that he might bring them bound before the chief priests?

The Greek Word for Call on is Composed of [On and Call (by name)]; thus, it is to Call Out Audibly, Even Loudly, as Stephen Did:

Acts 7:59 And they stoned Stephen as <u>he called upon the Lord</u> and said, <u>Lord Jesus, receive my spirit!</u>

Acts 22:15-16 For you will be a witness to Him unto all men of the things which you have seen and heard. And now, why do you delay? Rise up and be baptized and wash away your sins, <u>calling on His name</u>.

Paul's Charge to Timothy

2 Timothy 2:22 But flee youthful lusts, and pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
