The Burning Thornbush

Exodus 3:2 And the Angel of Jehovah appeared to him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a thornbush. And when he looked, there was the thornbush, burning with fire; but the thornbush was not consumed.

Three Signs of Being Called by God

1. A Rod Becoming a Serpent

Exodus 4:3 Throw (the rod) on the ground. And he threw it on the ground, and it became a serpent; and Moses recoiled from it.

Three Signs of Being Called by God

2. The Hand Becoming Leprous

Exodus 4:6 Now put your hand into your bosom. And he put his hand into his bosom, and when he took it out, there his hand was, leprous, as white as snow.

Romans 1:9 For God is my witness, whom I serve in my spirit in the gospel of His Son, how unceasingly I make mention of you always in my prayers

Three Signs of Being Called by God

3. The Water Becoming Blood

Exodus 4:9 Take some of the water of the River and pour it on the dry ground, and the water that you take out of the River will become blood upon the dry ground.
