

Drinking and Flowing the Water of Life

Exodus 17:1, 3-6

1 And all the assembly of the children of Israel journeyed from the wilderness of Sin by their stages according to the command of Jehovah and encamped in Rephidim, and there was no water for the people to drink. 3 So the people thirsted there for water, and the people murmured against Moses and said, For what reason did you bring us up out of Egypt; to kill us and our children and our livestock with thirst? 4 So Moses cried out to Jehovah, saying, What shall I do with this people? A little more, and they will stone me. 5 And Jehovah said to Moses...take in your hand your staff with which you struck the River, and go. 6 I will be standing before you there upon the rock in Horeb; and you shall strike the rock, and water will come out of it so that the people may drink. And Moses did so...

John 6:51 - I am the living bread which came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he shall live forever...

John 7:37 - Now on the last day...Jesus stood and cried out, saying, If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink...

Two Aspects of One Thing

John 4:14 - But whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall by no means thirst forever; but the water that I will give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into eternal life.

John 7:37-38 - ...If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes into Me, as the Scripture said, out of his innermost being shall flow rivers of living water.

Conditions For Us to Drink the Water of Life:

We need to speak to the Rock in our daily living (1 Cor. 10:4; Num. 20:7-8)

...they drank of a spiritual rock which followed them, and the rock was Christ.

Then Jehovah spoke to Moses, saying, Take the rod, and gather the assembly...and speak to the rock before their eyes, so that it yields its water.
