





Enslaved in Egypt







Passover





Regeneration

John 1:29 The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!









Crossing the Red Sea





Baptism





Led and Fed

Exodus 17:6a I will be standing before you there upon the rock in Horeb; and you shall strike the rock, and water will come out of it so that the people may drink.








John 6:35 Jesus said to them, I am the bread of life; he who comes to Me shall by no means hunger, and he who believes into Me shall by no means ever thirst.












Building the Tabernacle

Exodus 35:1 And Moses gathered all the assembly of the children of Israel and said to them, These are the words which Jehovah has commanded you to do.














God's Glory Filled the Tabernacle
