



### **Judges 6:36-40: Gideon and the Fleece**

**Gideon is hesitant to lead, requiring reassurance despite a previous promise from God.**

**He tests God twice—first with a wet fleece on dry ground, then a dry fleece on wet ground—seeking assurance due to doubt.**

**Doubt is not the opposite of faith—unbelief is. Doubt is often faith searching for understanding.**

**Others have struggled with doubt in scriptures**

**Jesus responds as God does... with Mercy**

**Doubt can be a doorway - not a dead end.**

**Anchor your heart on what you know**
