## Feeding – Teaching – Leaving

Feeding (Vss 1-15)  
Leaving (Vss 16-21)  
Teaching (Vss 22-40)  
Murmuring (Vss 41-51)  
Striving (Vss 52-59)  
Departing (Vss 60-71)

Little is much when God is involved  
Give Him what you have and let Him do the rest  
BUT – give ALL that you have - the lad did not hold back a little for himself

Never forget to bless what God has provided (Vs 11 & 23)  
Matthew-Mark-Luke mention Jesus looked to heaven before blessing the food  
Never forget our Heavenly Father is the source of ALL blessings

Stop complaining about what you DON'T have  
And try thanking God for what you DO have

Physical food is temporary  
Spiritual food is eternal
