## Chapter 14

### ❖ Baal-zephon

- v2 “Tell the people of Israel to turn back and encamp in front of Pi-hahiroth, between Migdol and the sea, in front of Baal-zephon; you shall encamp facing it, by the sea.
- v4 “And I will harden Pharaoh’s heart, and he will pursue them, and I will get glory over Pharaoh and all his host, and the Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord.” And they did so.”

# ● Mt. Zaphon

- Modern day Jebel al-Aqra, on Mediterranean coast between Turkey and Syria
- Site of Ba'al's palace
  - Ba'al was a "storm god"
- Other storm gods worshipped at Mt. Zaphon:
  - Zeus - Greece
  - Jupiter - Roman
  - Hittite - Tarhunt
  - Hurrian - Tessub
- Hebrew prophets make reference to Zaphon being Ba'al's home
- Psalms make a direct comparison between Zaphon and Yahweh's holy mountain, Mt. Zion
- Zaphon and therefore "north" became a reference point for evil. "Tsaphon", became the Hebrew word for the compass point north
  - Isaiah 14:13
