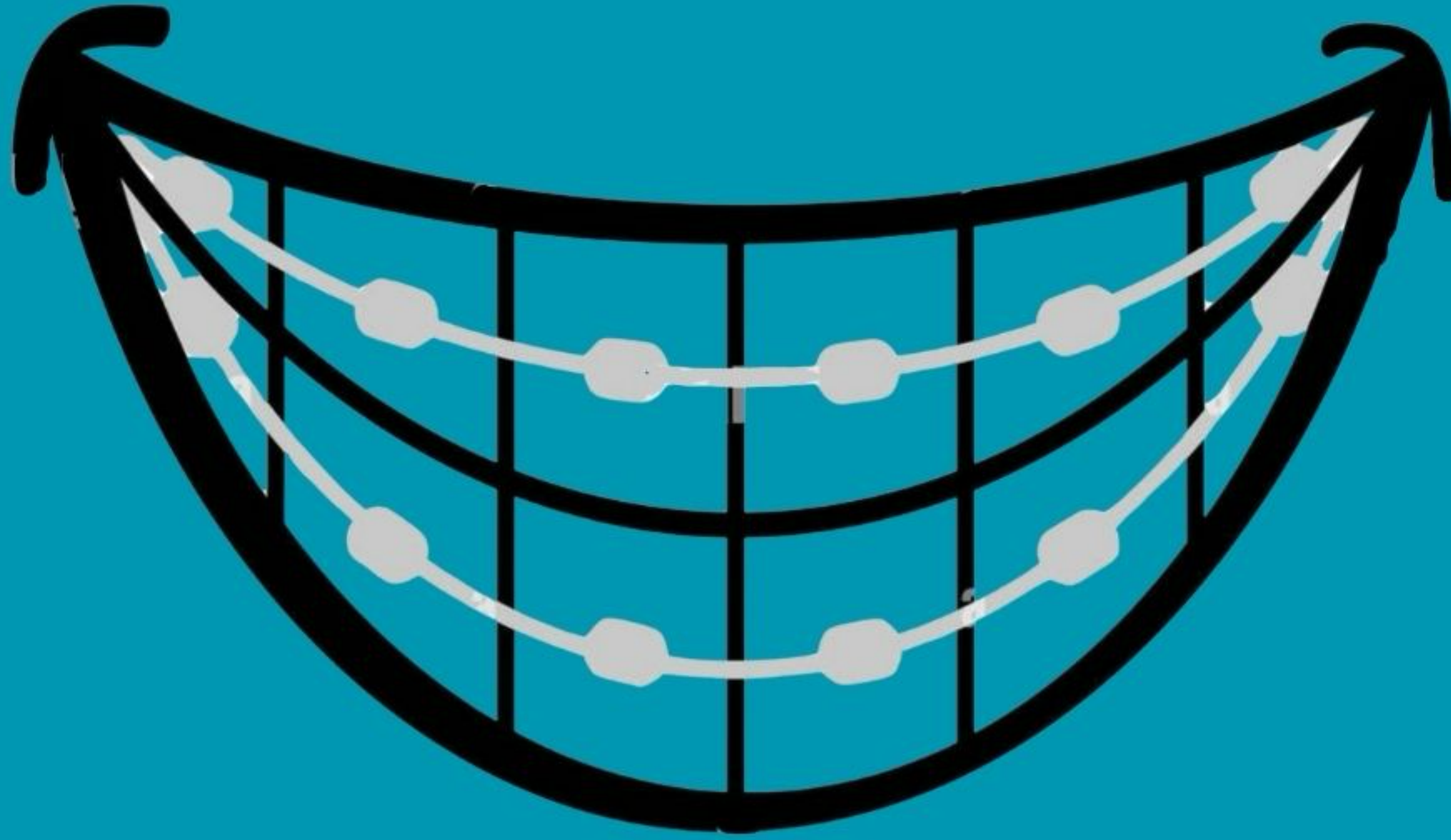

Series Big Idea: Just like the church in Crete, sometimes the modern-day church requires an “alignment” from God’s Word.

Today’s Thought: “Many times, the modern church would rather have a pastor with an MBA than an MDiv. The church is not a business, looking to draw a crowd; it is a body MADE to Worship, Witness, and Work. The pastor’s job is not to run a business or to be a charismatic personality who attracts people. The pastor is a shepherd of the Church Body. To truly understand the role of the Pastor, we must learn from the Bible and unlearn any unbiblical, man-made traditions.”

**“THE REQUIREMENTS
OF A GODLY PASTOR”**

“MANY TIMES, THE MODERN CHURCH WOULD RATHER HAVE A PASTOR WITH AN MBA THAN AN MDiv. THE CHURCH IS NOT A BUSINESS, LOOKING TO DRAW A CROWD; IT IS A BODY MADE TO WORSHIP, WITNESS, AND WORK. THE PASTOR’S JOB IS NOT TO RUN A BUSINESS OR TO BE A CHARISMATIC PERSONALITY WHO ATTRACTS PEOPLE. THE PASTOR IS A SHEPHERD OF THE CHURCH BODY. TO TRULY UNDERSTAND THE ROLE OF THE PASTOR, WE MUST LEARN FROM THE BIBLE AND UNLEARN ANY UNBIBLICAL, MAN-MADE TRADITIONS.”

TITUS 1:6-9 (NKJV)

6 IF A MAN IS BLAMELESS, THE HUSBAND OF ONE WIFE, HAVING FAITHFUL CHILDREN NOT ACCUSED OF DISSIPATION OR INSUBORDINATION. 7 FOR A BISHOP MUST BE BLAMELESS, AS A STEWARD OF GOD, NOT SELF-WILLED, NOT QUICK-TEMPERED, NOT GIVEN TO WINE, NOT VIOLENT, NOT GREEDY FOR MONEY, 8 BUT HOSPITABLE, A LOVER OF WHAT IS GOOD, SOBER-MINDED, JUST, HOLY, SELF-CONTROLLED, 9 HOLDING FAST THE FAITHFUL WORD AS HE HAS BEEN TAUGHT, THAT HE MAY BE ABLE, BY SOUND DOCTRINE, BOTH TO EXHORT AND CONVICT THOSE WHO CONTRADICT.

– “OVERSEES” THE OPERATIONS OF THE
CHURCH

-- LOVES THE PEOPLE HE SHEPHERDS
