Small Group Guide: Micah Chapter 1 - The Danger of Idolatry

Opening Prayer: Begin with a prayer asking God to guide your discussion and help apply the lessons from Micah to your lives today.

Key Takeaways:

- 1. God takes sin and idolatry seriously, and will ultimately judge it.
- 2. Idolatry is not just an Old Testament issue but remains relevant today.
- 3. Our sin nature is "incurable" on our own, but God provides the solution through Jesus Christ.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. The sermon mentioned modern forms of idolatry. What are some "idols" people struggle with today? How can we identify idols in our own lives?
- 2. Reflect on Ezekiel 14:3 "Anyone of the house of Israel who takes his idols into his heart..." How can idols take root in our hearts even if we're not physically bowing to statues?
- 3. The pastor shared a quote: "I will preach the truth, but my personal life is my own business." What's problematic about this mindset? How can we ensure our faith impacts all areas of our lives?
- 4. Discuss the story of the woman caught in adultery (John 8). How does Jesus' response demonstrate both justice and mercy? How can we apply this balance in our own lives?
- 5. The sermon emphasized the importance of sharing our faith. What holds us back from telling others about Christ? How can we overcome these barriers?
- 6. Reflect on the "balance sheet of life" shared at the beginning. Which aspects stood out to you? How might this perspective change how you approach your daily life?

Practical Applications:

- 1. Self-Examination: Take time this week to prayerfully examine your life for any "idols" that may be competing with God for priority. Write these down and commit to addressing them.
- 2. Prioritize God: Make a list of your top priorities. Where does God fit in? Brainstorm practical ways to ensure He remains first in your daily life.
- 3. Share Your Faith: Identify one person in your life who doesn't know Christ. Commit to praying for an opportunity to share your faith with them this week.
- 4. Scripture Memorization: Memorize 1 John 5:21 "Little children, keep yourselves from idols." Use this as a reminder throughout your day.

Closing Prayer: Close by thanking God for His mercy and grace, asking for strength to live lives that prioritize Him above all else.
