## Foundations - Truth

*"A lie can travel halfway around the world before the truth can put its pants on"*  
– Winston Churchill

John 14:6 (NIV) – Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me".

"truth" = Greek *aletheia* – "true to fact; reality"

Hebrews 6:16-19a (NIV) – "People swear by someone greater than themselves, and the oath confirms what is said and puts an end to all argument. Because God wanted to make the unchanging nature of His purpose very clear to the heirs of what was promised, He confirmed it with an oath. God did this so that, by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have fled to take hold of the hope set before us may be greatly encouraged. We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure".

John 18:33-34 (NKJV) – Then Pilate entered the Praetorium again, called Jesus, and said to Him, "Are you the King of the Jews?" Jesus answered him, "Are you speaking for yourself about this, or did others tell you this concerning me?"

John 18:35-38a (NKJV) – Pilate answered, "Am I a Jew? Your own nation and the chief priests have delivered you to me. What have you done?" Jesus answered, "My kingdom is not of this world. If my kingdom were of this world, my servants would fight, so that I should not be delivered to the Jews; but now my kingdom is not from here".

Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are you a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears my voice". Pilate said to Him, "What is truth?"

John 17:16-19 (NIV) – "They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified".

Psalms 119:160 (NKJV) – "The entirety of your word is truth, and every one of your righteous judgments endures forever".

John 16:13 (NIV) – "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on His own; He will speak only what He hears, and He will tell you what is yet to come".

John 17:1-3 (NIV) – After Jesus said this, He looked toward heaven and prayed:  
"Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you. For you granted Him authority over all people that He might give eternal life to all those you have given Him. Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent".

Joshua 24:14-15 (NIV) – "Now fear the Lord and serve Him with all faithfulness. Throw away the gods your ancestors worshiped beyond the Euphrates River and in Egypt, and serve the Lord. But if serving the Lord seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord".

Nehemiah 9:13-15 (NIV) – "You came down on Mount Sinai; you spoke to them from heaven. You gave them regulations and laws that are just and right, and decrees and commands that are good. You made known to them your holy Sabbath and gave them commands, decrees, and laws through your servant Moses. In their hunger you gave them bread from heaven and in their thirst you brought them water from the rock; you told them to go in and take possession of the land you had sworn with uplifted hand to give them".

Nehemiah 9:16-18 (NIV) – "But they, our ancestors, became arrogant and stiff-necked, and they did not obey your commands. They refused to listen and failed to remember the miracles you performed among them. They became stiff-necked and in their rebellion appointed a leader in order to return to their slavery. But you are a forgiving God, gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love. Therefore, you did not desert them, even when they cast for themselves an image of a calf and said, 'This is our god, who brought you up out of Egypt', or when they committed awful blasphemies".

Romans 1:18-20 (NIV) – "The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of people, who suppress the truth by their wickedness, since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities – His eternal power and divine nature – have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse".

Romans 1:25 (NIV) – "They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator – who is forever praised. Amen.

### Bottom Line – Key Points

1. Truth is not merely a piece of information or data; it is a person, and His name is Jesus Christ.
2. We cannot obtain the whole truth by simply reading about God; it also requires us to know Him personally.
3. Anytime we choose to put creature over Creator, we are exchanging the truth about God for the lie that every sinner in the history of the world has believed.
