Foundations - The Bible

Pastor Logan Ames

2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NIV) – "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work".

"God-breathed" = Greek *theopneustos* – *theos* (God) + *pneo* (to blow or breathe hard)

pneo - "portrays the dynamic action of wind that can range from a gentle breeze to a driving storm. Scripture uses the verb to evoke the power, unpredictability, and sovereignty of God who both sends and restrains the winds"

– *Strong's Exhaustive Concordance*

Psalms 119:103-105 (NIV) – "How sweet are your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth! I gain understanding from your precepts; therefore, I hate every wrong path. Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path".

Genesis 2:4-7 (NIV) – "This is the account of the heavens and the earth when they were created, when the Lord God made the earth and the heavens. Now no shrub had yet appeared on the earth and no plant had yet sprung up, for the Lord God had not sent rain on the earth and there was no one to work the ground, but streams came up from the earth and watered the whole surface of the ground. Then the Lord God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being".

John 20:21-23 (NIV) – Again, Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you". And with that, He breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone's sins, their sins are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven".

Hebrews 4:12-13 (NIV) – "For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of Him to whom we must give account".

Romans 2:12-16 (NIV) – "All who sin apart from the law will also perish apart from the law, and all who sin under the law will be judged by the law. For it is not those who hear the law who are righteous in God's sight, but it is those who obey the law who will be declared righteous. (Indeed, when Gentiles, who do not have the law, do by nature things required by the law, they are a law for themselves, even though they do not have the law.

They show that the requirements of the law are written on their hearts, their consciences also bearing witness, and their thoughts sometimes accusing them and at other times even defending them). This will take place on the day when God judges people's secrets through Jesus Christ, as my gospel declares".

Joshua 1:1-3 (NIV) – After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, the Lord said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses' aide: "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them – to the Israelites. I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses".

Joshua 1:7-8 (NIV) – "Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it.

Then you will be prosperous and successful".

"meditate" = Hebrew *hagah* – "to mutter, growl, speak, muse, or ponder"

Deuteronomy 31:24-27 (NIV) – After Moses finished writing in a book the words of this law from beginning to end, he gave this command to the Levites who carried the ark of the covenant of the Lord: "Take this Book of the Law and place it beside the ark of the covenant of the Lord your God. There it will remain as a witness against you.

For I know how rebellious and stiff-necked you are. If you have been rebellious against the Lord while I am still alive and with you, how much more will you rebel after I die!"

Nehemiah 8:9-11 (NIV) – Then Nehemiah the governor, Ezra the priest and teacher of the law, and the Levites who were instructing the people said to them all, "This day is holy to the Lord your God. Do not mourn or weep". For all the people had been weeping as they listened to the words of the Law. Nehemiah said, "Go and enjoy choice food and sweet drinks, and send some to those who have nothing prepared. This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the joy of the Lord is your strength". The Levites calmed all the people, saying, "Be still, for this is a holy day. Do not grieve".

1 Corinthians 3:11 (NIV) – "For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ".

Bottom Line – Key Points

1. The sheer amount of failures of the supposed heroes in the Bible is proof that it can be trusted as genuine.
2. Preachers don't make the Bible come to life; it gives them life, along with all who receive and submit to it.
3. The word of God bears witness about us not only to God, but also to ourselves, which changes us.
