Luke 17:20-21 (NKJV) – Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The

kingdom of God does not come with observation; nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you".

Romans 8:31 (NIV) – "What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

Isaiah 43:18-19 (NIV) – "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland".

1 Kings 17:1-9 (NIV) –Now Elijah the Tishbite, from Tishbe^[a] in Gilead, said to Ahab, "As the LORD, the God of Israel, lives, whom I serve, there will be neither dew nor rain in the next few years except at my word." Then the word of the LORD came to Elijah: "Leave here, turn eastward and hide in the Kerith Ravine, east of the Jordan. You will drink from the brook, and I have directed the ravens to supply you with food there." So he did what the LORD had told him. He went to the Kerith Ravine, east of the Jordan, and stayed there. The ravens brought him bread and meat in the morning and bread and meat in the evening, and he drank from the brook.
