Foundations - Forgiveness

1 Peter 1:20 (NIV) - He was chosen before the creation of the world,
but was revealed in these last times for your sake.

Revelation 13:8 (NKJV) - All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names
have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation.

Luke 23:34 (NIV) - Jesus said, "Father, forgive them,
for they do not know what they are doing.

Genesis 50:15-20 (NIV) - When Joseph's brothers saw that their father was dead,
they said, "What if Joseph holds a grudge against us and pays us back for all the
wrongs we did to him?" So they sent word to Joseph, saying, "Your father left these
instructions before he died: 'This is what you are to say to Joseph: I ask you to
forgive your brothers the sins and the wrongs they committed in treating you so
badly.' Now please forgive the sins of the servants of the God of your father."
When their message came to him, Joseph wept. His brothers then came and threw
themselves down before him. "We are your slaves," they said. But Joseph said to
them, "Don't be afraid. Am I in the place of God? You intended to harm me, but God
intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives.

Job 42:7 (NIV) - After the Lord had said these things to Job, he said to Eliphaz the
Temanite, "I am angry with you and your two friends, because you have not spoken
the truth about me, as my servant Job has.

Exodus 10:16-18 (NIV) - Pharaoh quickly summoned Moses and Aaron and said,
"I have sinned against the Lord your God and against you. Now forgive my sin once
more and pray to the Lord your God to take this deadly plague away from me."
Moses then left Pharaoh and prayed to the Lord.

Matthew 6: 9-13 (NIV) - "This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father in heaven,
hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our
debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

Matthew 18:21-22 (NKJV) - Then Peter came to Him and said, "Lord, how often shall
my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" Jesus said to
him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven.
