Revelation 3:1 (NIV) – "To the angel of the church in Sardis write: "These are the words of Him who holds the seven spirits of God and the seven stars. I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead".

Revelation 3:1 (MSG) – "Write this to Sardis, to the Angel of the church. The One holding the Seven Spirits of God in one hand, a firm grip on the Seven Stars in the other, speaks: I see right through your work. You have a reputation for vigor and zest, but you're dead, stone-dead".

"dead" = Greek *nekros* – "lifeless, powerless, unresponsive to life-giving influences" (HELPS)

"A perfect model of inoffensive Christianity" - G.B. Caird on Sardis

Acts 1:8 (NIV) – "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth".

2 Timothy 3:5 (NIV) - "having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with such people".

Revelation 3:2-3 (NIV) – "Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have found your deeds unfinished in the sight of my God. Remember, therefore, what you have received and heard; hold it fast, and repent. But if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what time I will come to you".
